Project #2: Animated Antonyms

Objective	<p>"Kinetically expressing the opposite meaning of words."</p> <p>Define the meaning of one term by juxtaposing it with its antonym. The interaction of the two words create a narrative. Can the words act symbiotically to express an antithetical concept? Or should there be a point and counterpoint where one scene complements the other? The relationship between the terms tell the story.</p>
Constraints	<p>Only letterforms in the terms may be used (no other shapes or graphics) The letterforms may be deconstructed and/or repeated, but practice good typography The terms do not necessarily have to appear as actual whole, independent words A viewer should be able to recognize the terms and infer their meaning from their interplay The animated sequence should loop for continuous playback</p>
Document	<p>Macromedia Flash 8 (or acceptable alternative) 800 x 450 landscape 30 frames per second 20 seconds or a little more High contrast, black, white and levels of gray or transparency Simple sans serif: Helvetica, Univers, etc.</p>
Deliverables	<p>Antonyms with definitions and brief narrative (week 5) Annotated storyboard (week 6) Animation (week 7)</p>
